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Terms & Conditions of Registration

A. Terms of Registration

1. Applicants for the Master Program in Islamic Thought and Muslim Societies (ITMS) must have an accredited undergraduate degree and an academic record of sufficient level to qualify for full or provisional admission.
2. Minimum requirements must be met in order for the application to be evaluated and considered for admission: a statement of purpose, a solid research proposal, a recommendation letter, and a certificate of English proficiency (TOEFL 525 or IELTS 6).
3. All documents submitted must be in English, or alternatively, an official translation must be attached for documents that were not originally issued in English.

B. Procedure for Registration

1. Pay the PMB selection fee;
2. Fill in personal data and upload documents on the online registration system;
3. Download and print the exam card as proof of having completed the registration.
